There seems to be an explosion of interest in exploring arts and technology connections: new media, digital media, and kinetic art are only some of the terms used to describe this fusion of disciplines. This emerging arena for collaboration brings up a number of questions. Are fine arts and technology compatible partners? Do these disciplines support each other or flinch when they are combined, like oil and water? In this talk, Erik Brunvand, Associate Professor at the University of Utah, will start with some thoughts on the nature of combining arts and technology, and show some historical and contemporary examples.
